### **Allover Quilting**

**Cost:** \$0.015-0.025 per square inch\*\*

**Minimum charge:** \$40.00

This includes basic pantographs\* or a simple freehand design covering the entire surface of the quilt top.

\*Currently I only have a few pantographs in stock, but have a catalog and will allow you to select one and order it for you. If the copyright is such that I can use the pantograph for other clients, then there will be no charge to you. Otherwise you will be required to purchase the pantograph and it will be yours to use as you see fit.

### **Custom Quilting**

**Cost:** \$0.025-0.04 per square inch\*\*

**Minimum charge:** \$40.00

Custom quilting includes anything that is not an allover design, i.e. separate border, block, and/or sashing treatments or designs. Price depends on the complexity and density of the design and will be determined in advance of quilting your quilt.

I have books and sketches of design ideas and/or you can bring your own ideas. Often the quilt itself will let us know how it wants to be quilted. It is up to you as to how involved you want to be in the quilt design process.



### **Binding Options**

**Piped Binding** – I will prepare, attach, and finish by machine a single layered piped binding for a charge of \$0.30 per linear inch.

**Topstitched Folded Binding** – I will prepare and attach a folded binding to the back and topstitch it on the front for a charge of \$0.20 per linear inch.

**Folded Binding** – I will prepare and attach a folded binding to the front for a charge of \$0.15 per linear inch. The client will be responsible for finishing this binding. It is recommended that this be done by hand.

**Customer Binding** – Customer prepares, attaches, and finishes the binding.

Fabric for any of the above binding choices is to be provided by the client.

## Batting

Either the client or I can provide the batting. The batting should be 4" larger than the quilt top on all sides. For example, if the top is 60" x 80", then the batting should be 68" x 88". The batting that I normally carry is Hobbs 80/20, but will use whatever you provide.

## Thread

I usually use Superior Threads; So Fine! is my preference. It is a #50/3 polyester thread. Standard solid colors are included free of charge. Colors not normally stocked and/or specialty threads will increase the cost of the service provided.

**Standard colors include:** snow (white), pearl, putty, mushroom, smoke (gray), black, hot chilies (red), rose petal (dusty pink), it's a girl (pastel pink), pineapple (yellow), mustard, navy, out of the blue (medium dusty blue), it's a boy! (baby blue), amethyst, thistle, forest (green), fern

## Backing

The client provides the backing fabric. It should be squared up and approximately 4" larger than the top on all sides. For example, if the top is 60" x 80", then the backing should be 68" x 88".

Backing should be pressed prior to dropping off or shipping.

## Quilt Top

The quilt top should be squared up and pressed prior to dropping off or shipping. Ideally you have pressed it as you have pieced it. Thread tails should be clipped.

DO **NOT** LAYER THE QUILT.

Batting, backing, and top should be separate to achieve the best results.

## Estimating Charges\*\*

For the examples below, we will be using a queen size quilt measuring 84" x 92". This would yield:

Surface area =  $84 \times 92 = 7728$  sq. inches

Perimeter =  $84 + 84 + 92 + 92 = 352$  in.

### Example 1:

Allover quilting of medium complexity,  
medium density at \$0.02 per sq. inch.

$$7728 \times 0.02 = \$154.56 (\$155)$$

### Example 2:

Custom quilting, medium complexity,  
medium density at \$0.03 per sq. inch.

$$7728 \times 0.03 = \$231.84 (\$230)$$

### Example 3 (Binding):

To prepare, attach, and finish by machine piped binding:

$$352 \times 0.30 = \$105.60 (\$105)$$

To prepare and attach folded binding

(customer to finish by hand):  $352 \times 0.15 = \$52.80 (\$55)$

**Quilts must be paid for before they are  
picked up or shipped.**

**NOTE:** Do **not** ship quilts to me without contacting me first. This is to insure that I will be there to receive the quilt when it arrives. Client is responsible for all shipping charges. Insurance is recommended.
